52% Syrah, 26% Grenache, 15% Mourvedre,
5% Petite Sirah, 2% Petite Verdot

At elevations ranging from 1,400 to 3,000 feet and located at the base of Mount Konocti, once an active volcano, the Red Hills AVA features rolling hills, red volcanic soils, and a lake effect breeze from Clear Lake, one of North America's oldest natural lakes.

WINEMAKERS NOTES

The 2015 Cimarron red blend is powerful and wild in itself. The volcanic soils and dry climate of Lake County are ideal for growing this blend of Syrah, Grenache and Mourvedre. We add a splash of Petite Sirah and Petite Verdot for a little extra Oomph! We ferment this at a warm 85°F to bring out the fruit characters of each varietal.
